

What it used to be like....for most of my adult life I used drugs. When the opioid epidemic hit, I started using them heavily for about 4 years. I was in absolute bondage to drugs. I became extremely isolated and full of fear and desperation. I wanted to stop but couldn't help myself.

What happened....the last time I overdosed , I almost died. They brought me back and then the police officer, who had responded searched my coat and found drugs in my coat pocket. Needless to say he arrested me and took me to jail. While in jail I thought about the times I had cried out to God for help, a God I didn't know and a God I had never honored. Then it hit me like a ton of bricks! He had answered my desperate cry. He had brought me down to the lowest point of my life and surrounded me by jail walls where I was forced to get off the drugs. Finally, after many years of addiction I was clean from drugs!!!

What it is like now...After being released from prison I came to the mission determined to find a new way to live. I needed time to ponder the course of this life, my life. I came to myself and then I came to know Jesus and his saving forgiveness. I have never looked back. The mission is the Lord's workshop. The staff and those that are over the mission are His tools. God is working miracles here on a daily basis. I thank Jesus for my salvation and for being the Lord of so many chances. He is an awesome God.

I will be there for you; you are not alone! Without supporters like you, I would not be able to help the ladies that come to me. One thing is for sure, together we are able to do so much more to reach the moms that need our help.
