As it has been in the last few years, we continue to have calls from moms needing a place to stay at least once or twice a week. Tammy had a mom in her office on Thursday of last week pregnant with a 13 year old daughter needing a place to stay until she could have the baby and get on her feet. I can't express how hard it is to look at a mom and say we don't have a place for you to stay. Of course, we tried to find somewhere for her to no avail. As far as I know she is staying at the overnight shelter in town and still trying to find a place to stay before her baby is born in August. There are countless stories like this one I could share. There is such a need for a Family Shelter here in the Burlington-Alamance County area. Please pray fervently that we can get things moving on a faster pace so that we can fill that need. God's timing is always the right timing we know, but we do wish it could be soon!!
