I am sure that by now everyone is aware of the global spread of the corona virus. It has caused us to think about the things that we take for granted and to rethink how we go about the practices of our daily lives and it has not been an easy adjustment. But in the midst of all the changes and confusion, let's remember we do not want or need to live in fear. I am not afraid of the corona virus because I know that God is bigger than any trouble we face. As believers, we have both a challenge and an opportunity to model for our children, for our families, and for each other what a faith-filled and faithful response can be. Instead of living in panic and in fear, we have a chance to remain calm and reasoned in this pandemic displaying a spirit of trust in our all powerful God.

Piedmont Rescue Mission has implemented safeguards to protect clients, volunteers, staff and the wider community. Based on public health recommendations, we have suspended the operation of Good Samaritan Super Thrift Store until further notice. The store accounts for a good percentage of the Missions' income. The Thrift Store was closed and employees sent home on March 30<sup>th</sup>. Please pray for our store staff that God will meet their needs during this time. Yet, utilities and rents will continue to need to be paid even though we are without revenue. We will be listing items for sale at the store on our GSST Facebook and you can purchase online and pick up at the store at a designated time, you can help us by purchasing any item that you can. We are also considering opening the store under limited hours 1 or 2 days per week. We will let you know on the GSST Facebook page if and when we do.

We continue to provide three meals a day to the men at the mission, we continue giving out approx 50 food boxes every week to needy families, and helping the girls at the pregnancy center to get the things that they need, as we employ social distancing and other preventive measures. Our staff is diligently working and is doing everything they can to ensure everyone remains healthy and safe. Also, the mission has set aside space for isolating men who may show symptoms of COVID-19. We are reminding everyone here to wash their hands multiple times per day. We are sanitizing frequently touched surfaces multiple times a day as well as using disinfectants in the building. However, the Rescue Mission is having difficulty purchasing hand sanitizer, loaf bread, disinfectant wipes, baby wipes, diapers and bleach if you are able to help with any of these items call the mission at 336-229-6995, Monday - Thursday between 8:00 AM and 4:00 PM. Also **please don't forget the mission financially during this time.** We need your help now! With decreased income we need you to get us through this storm. God will see us through and He will do it through people like you who care about what we are doing. Thank you so much for your generous support.

I know the COVID-19 pandemic is hard on you, your family and the churches. It is disrupting all our lives and prompting everyone to make adjustments to slow the spread of the virus. You can be assured that as long as this situation persists, Tammy, I and Piedmont Rescue Mission will be praying for you please keep praying for us. We are taking every precaution against the virus and seeking God's wisdom in all that we do.
