I would like to start this letter by saying Thank You to all of you who have continued your support and sent in extra funds during this hard time for all of us. As we enter June, the situation really doesn't seem to be getting much better, but we have our hope in Christ and know that through patience and prayer things will get better.

We have begun taking in new clients at **Alamance Rescue Mission**. At this time we have 6 new men who have been screened for the virus before allowing them in. It has been hard to turn men away because of the virus so we are glad we are able to bring new guys in now. We are continuing a routine of sanitizing the building two times a day to assure we are keeping the men safe. Most of the men that were laid off due to the virus have been called back to work and the others are able to continue looking for employment with safety measures in place. The men have maintained their church services here at the mission except on Sunday morning going to drive in service at the church. We are thankful for those who have come in to preach and sing for the men at these services.

Alamance Pregnancy Services has celebrated the birth of 5 babies in the last month. Two of the babies were born full term and are at home safe with their moms. Three of them have been in the hospital. One is just before being released from the hospital now. The other two that are twins is a story of sadness and joy mixed. One was 3 pounds at birth and the other was 2 pounds. The baby that was 2 pounds lived only a few hours before she passed away. The 3 pound is still in the hospital but doing really good. Please pray for her to gain weight and get healthy enough to go home with her mom. Pray for her mom as she travels back and forth to the hospital and as she mourns the loss of one of her baby.

The Lord blessed the pregnancy service this month with a great donation from a high school girl. She chose us for her senior project. When she delivered all she had gotten together for us I was overwhelmed. I asked her to share with me about how she got the items together. She told me she was working at a local coffee shop and she saved all her tip money to purchase the items and several people gave her money to help too. Her tip money was \$800.00. I tried to get a picture of all she brought but it was hard to show how much it was. I think it was 10 boxes of diapers, 15 cases of wipes, 100 pacifiers, 3 cases of baby food, 3 cases of baby cereal, and 100 sets of 3 month Carter baby clothes.



The **Family Shelter** has also had some exciting things going on. We had a young man donate 50 hours of his time to frame out the kitchen and dining room preparing it for the electrician and plumber to come in and do their work. It is taking shape one board at a time. Thank you for your continued prayer and support for this very needed shelter. We hope to get some more work groups on the sight in the near future.



The **Good Samaritan Super Thrift Store** has opened its doors to customers and donation on a part time status as of now. God has blessed it in the opening back up process.
