Within minutes of being in our office this young lady was in tears after hearing how we would be able to help her through the most difficult time in her life. Knowing that she had help from us gave her peace and comfort but knowing that God loves her and wants to help her in her life will give her more peace than we could ever give her. Pray her heart will be open to receiving the peace that passes all understanding in Christ as she attends our classes.

In the rescue mission, men come in at the end of their rope, they have lost their job, their family and yes even their self respect. They fear that they will never be the same again. We have the message of hope in Christ to share with them and help them see if they put their trust in Him they can live without fear knowing that his love cast out all fear. Fear of rejection is gone because they have trusted in the one who will never reject one that calls on him.
