Pray her heart will be open to receiving the peace that passes all understanding in Christ as she attends our classes.

In the rescue mission, men come in at the end of their rope, they have lost their job, their family and yes even their self respect. They fear that they will never be the same again. We have the message of hope in Christ to share with them and help them see if they put their trust in Him they can live without fear knowing that his love cast out all fear. Fear of rejection is gone because they have trusted in the one who will never reject one that calls on him.

As you celebrate Valentine's Day this year, don't forget the perfect love that cast our all fear and rejoice in Him who gives us that perfect love.
