There are a few more rooms to divide and frame out the walls. A great big thank you to the men doing the framing work. We have also been encouraged by several people wanting to adopt a whole apartment to furnish and decorate.



The need for this shelter grows everyday. The calls that we receive concerning housing for women and their children vary from family abuse issues, drug and alcohol addictions, homeless, and jobless, with no help from extended families. Our hearts break with some of the calls we get from mom's who are in desperate situations and then we have to tell them our shelter is not open yet. Please help us pray we won't have to do this much longer. We know God is “able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think” The phrase that sticks out to me in this verse is that he is able to do exceeding abundantly above not only what we ask but what we think. What a blessing it is to know he goes further than even what we ask of Him.
