I won’t lie to you, I had been to the mission before but had left without receiving the love of God they were so eager to share with me. The day came when I finally realized I was at the end of my rope and things definitely needed to change before there was nothing left of me. This time I came with an open mind and heart to receive the Lord and to give my life to Him completely. He has not let me down. God has blessed me so much since coming to the mission. I am working in the kitchen, where I love to be. I am a cook by trade and now I am cooking for the men here and sharing the love that God gave me. The mission has been such a blessing in my life. I thank God that He didn’t give up on me, my mother and aunt didn’t give up on me and my Piedmont Rescue Mission Family didn’t give up on me. The mission gives me the spiritual support I need and they show that they truly care about me living for the Lord. The Lord truly has created a clean heart in me and renewed a right spirit within me.”

We are in the beginning of Piedmont Rescue Mission’s 40th year of ministry. The year started off with our whole family having Covid, which stretched out over the whole month of January. Praise God we are through the worst of it. I have had trouble regaining my energy levels but thankfully this week I am doing much better. Please pray for health for all the men and staff here at PRM too.

I am pushing to get things moving again on the Women’s Shelter so please pray we will begin to see an end in sight. God has blessed us in so many ways we can’t begin to tell you how much. We will keep you up to date on the progress as time goes by. We need your prayers and your support, whether by volunteering or by giving donations.
