On the Alamance Rescue Mission side, we are getting more men to come into the program and seeing several of them move on to a better life as a result of the change God has made in their lives. He alone is able to do "exceedingly and abundantly above anything we can ask or think"!

The Women and Children's Shelter is moving along too. A group from Bethel Baptist Church spent a whole Saturday hanging sheet rock for us. They were able to get almost 3 of the apartments finished. We have quite a bit more to do so if you have a group that wants to come out and help call 33-212-2802. The plumber is on his way to starting and thanks to a plumbing supply company in Burlington we are acquiring the materials needed at a good price. Please keep praying for the progress on the shelter. We are getting excited about the time nearing for us to open its doors.

We were privileged this year to be part of the Post Office Food Drive here in Alamance County. We had a great team of volunteers who spent a big part of their day on that Saturday unloading the food donations from the mail trucks and packing them in bins for the organizations that were involved to pick up and take to their food pantries. We are so thankful for the extra food to help us feed our men and give out to the community.
