Please pray for strength and victory in the lives of the residents here at PRM.

The Women and Children’s shelter is moving along, but not quite as fast as we would like to see it move. Please pray that God will help those we depend on in this day of labor & supply shortages to be enabled to get the workers and supplies they need to get the job done.
