I am sure that Mother's Day will be passed by the time you receive this letter, and I am sorry. Time flies so fast it is hard to keep up with getting the letters out. In honor of Mother's Day, I want to feature the Women and Children's Shelter. In the month of April, we had so many volunteers working at the shelter. We have had several groups and several individuals that come out at least twice a week to do what they can do. God has blessed us with volunteers!

We were blessed with flooring for the whole building at an unbelievable price thanks to a local businessman. The electricians are trying to finish up their part of the work. Duct work is in the process of being completed. Bathrooms are still a work in progress, we are working on getting exhaust fans installed and the water heater installation needs to be finished. The kitchen electrical is being finished and a grease pit will have to be installed. We have some minor roofing that needs to be repaired. We also must replace some of the subflooring because of water damage. We are in the process of changing all lighting fixtures to LED. As you can see there is still lots that has to be completed but we are pushing forward!

The calls continue to come in from mother's with children that need a safe place to live. We have calls from Mom's with up to 4 children and then Mom's with babies. It is so hard to say, I'm sorry our facility is not open yet. Hopefully
