A Message From Tony and Tammy Honeycutt

I am constantly overwhelmed how fast time passes. We are already writing the March prayer letter. When you stay busy, I guess time does go by faster and have we ever been busy these first 3 months of the year.

We are so thankful for all the help that we have had with the Family Shelter, the electrical and heating and air system have been worked on and hopefully, when it passes inspection, we can turn the heat on.

The roof on the Piedmont Rescue Mission building is completed except for the flat part of the roof. We have a good friend that is donating the materials for the flat roof, so as soon as I can arrange to go pick it up that part will be finished also. We have been renovating one of the bigger rooms here at the mission to divide it into 5 rooms. This will allow us to add even more men to the program.

Alamance Pregnancy Services has been doing well also. Jeanne has settled into the office and has been working hard to bring in more clients by sending out letters to doctor’s offices, hospitals and Social Services offices. Please pray God will honor her hard work and send ladies to the office for her to minister to.

There has been a lot of flu in the mission the last two months and right now we are dealing with a stomach bug. Please pray all will be well soon. Last night we had one of the men collapse in the hallway. The supervisors called 911 and they talked the supervisor through what to do until the EMT arrived. This man is in the hospital on a breathing tube and unconscious. Please pray for him.

We had two of the men in the mission make a profession of faith in Jesus two weeks ago. What a blessing they have been. They are both showing signs of being genuine in their commitment. Please pray for them. One of them is our cook and the other works a job outside the mission, he has asked for prayer to stay strong at work. If you haven’t struggled with addiction its hard to understand how hard it is to fight it. Just like anything else in life we can’t do anything without the Lord’s help and without the prayers of God’s people. Prayer is such an important part of the ministry. Psalms 127:1 says; **“Except the Lord build the house, they labor in vain that build it; except the Lord keep the city, the watchman waketh but in vain.”** It also says in Philippians 1:6 says; **“Being confident of this very thing that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ.”** What blessed promises we have in the scripture!
